Application Criteria

1. A senior graduating from either Broadneck or Severna Park High Schools.
2. Matriculating to a four-year college or university.
3. U.S. Citizen.
4. Award will be made based on your financial need, academic success, a demonstrated history in community service, and your plan to continue serving the community during and after college.
5. **Complete scholarship application including official high school transcript and recommendation letters should be emailed as a pdf to your school guidance office and scholarships@severnriverlions.org.**

The Scholarship Award

1. This scholarship is fifteen hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) and is awarded for **one year only**.
2. It will be paid directly to the college or university in two equal payments (one for the fall semester and one for the spring semester – no exceptions).
3. If the SRLC scholarship winner is appointed to a U.S. Service Academy, the award will be withdrawn. The scholarship may be awarded to another applicant at the discretion of the committee.
4. If a scholarship recipient withdraws from the four-year college or university he or she is attending for any reason, the scholarship shall be terminated and will not be renewed should the student later return to school.
5. If the SRLC scholarship winner is awarded a full scholarship from another source, the SRLC scholarship will be terminated. It is the duty of the scholarship recipient to notify SRLC of such an additional scholarship award.
